Updates

SUNY Digital Learning Environment (DLE)

Just over 4,000 SUNY faculty and staff, representing nearly every SUNY campus, have gotten an inside look at D2L's Brightspace learning management system, the hub of SUNY's new digital learning environment. Below are additional highlights from the continued planning and implementation.

- The sandbox was established so that those who will support faculty and use Brightspace have a chance to try out its various features now, as planning continues.
- A new resource document has been posted to the DLE website outlining Brightspace Core and Performance Plus features for SUNY.
- Cohort 1 campuses have been announced along with a three-phase timeline for migration.
- Two additional work groups have been formed: the Technical Implementation Work Group, and the Campus Implementation Planning Work Group. The latter established two sub work groups around Templates and Training.
- Training supports have been developed for Phases 2 & 3. Each campus cohort will follow a similar training path with instructional support beginning first. Pilot faculty will follow shortly thereafter, and then non-pilot faculty; both will receive training with sufficient time to migrate and prepare their courses in the new platform.

OSCQR 4.0: Interactive version now available!

SUNY Online is very pleased to announce the release of [OSCQR 4.0!](#) SUNY Online worked with a [volunteer campus-based workgroup](#), from across the SUNY System, to update OSCQR to reflect and support the US federal Department of Education regulation regarding requirements for [Regular and Substantive Interaction \(RSI\)](#) in all online/distance education courses for financial aid purposes that went into effect on July 1, 2021. OSCQR is the first online course quality rubric that specifically addresses the new US Department of Education regulation requirements for “Regular and Substantive Interaction (RSI)” in the design of online courses.

The [self- assessment tool](#) has already been downloaded nearly 7,000 times. The [interactive OSCQR rubric and dashboard](#) have also been updated and are available.

Workplace Platform Transition

The SUNY Learning Commons platform was created in 2001 and has thrived on a variety of host platforms including Joomla, WordPress and currently the [Workplace/Facebook platform](#). Today, our current platform boasts almost 12,000 SUNY users, more than 2,000 guests and over 700 groups.

Earlier this year, the CPD received word from Workplace regarding key changes to their educational outreach program under our current contractual agreement. Because of this, the CPD, with advisement from key members of the Provosts executive team, have made the decision to migrate to another platform beginning later this year. We are diligently working to construct and configure our new home inside of Microsoft's Yammer/Communities app which is part of MS Teams. We are working to ensure a seamless transition of groups and will be available to train, demonstrate and assist individuals and communities of practice throughout the adoption process. While our goal is to transition from the Workplace platform by 2022, we encourage you and your community members to continue to communicate in Workplace, which we have available through March 2022.
