DLE Update

SUNY Digital Learning Environment (DLE)

Cohort 1 is underway! Each cohort undergoes a three-phase process expected to take between 11-13 months.

The first cohort will run from January/February of 2022 through December 2022; the second from May 2022 to April 2023; the third from September 2022 through August of 2023; and the fourth from January 2023 to December 2023.

Training opportunities have recently been announced. Fireside chats provide an overview of the training plans, introduce participants to the training team, showcase Brightspace tools and features, and provide an opportunity for participants to submit questions and suggestions to be addressed at subsequent fireside chats. For the spring 2022 semester, recruitment and marketing for SUNY Online Signature Programs (Degrees at Scale) generated over 9,000 inquiries and 2,500 applications. We are happy to welcome over 600 newly enrolled students, bringing the current number of students served through this initiative to just over 2,000!
