CAMPUS AND STUDENT LIFE

- New ad-hoc committee this year
 - Resolutions: gender inclusivity (non-binary gender distinctions), child care funding
 - Reviewing and sharing student housing policies
 - Are and how are retention initiatives being assessed?

- New briefing book (community colleges at a glance)

GOVERNANCE

- Resolutions: continued funding model (100% of previous year), faculty on presidential searches, role of shared governance in consortia,
- Resolution in process: open presidential searches
- Position statement: faculty on administrative searches below president (in process)

COMMITTEE INVOLVEMENT AND CONCERNS

- SUNY online advisory committee – yet to be formed (AI, packback)
- General education task force – planning stages (charge in process)
- Student mobility steering committee – transfer pathways review and assessment of seamless transfer
- Student mental health and wellness task force (very large committee) sub-committee:
 - Wellness – prevention, health promotion
 - Assessment – capacity, resources, personnel
 - Campus-wide engagement – faculty/staff professional development
 - Clinical – psychiatry, clinical services delivery methods
 - System-wide structure and support – procurement, contracts, technology

INITIATIVES

- Guided pathways – 18 cc's now involved (10 rolled out this fall, 8 attending institutes)
- Accelerated learning program (ALP) – co-requisite courses, “just in time learning” to eliminate developmental education by combining with credit bearing courses
